Course Description

Latin 101-3 is the third quarter of the year-long Elementary Latin sequence designed to introduce students to the basic principles of classical Latin grammar and syntax. In addition to the mastering of these basic tools, the course will focus on vocabulary acquisition and the development of translation skills and reading competency necessary to continue successfully in the second year. During the first three weeks of the quarter, class meetings will be devoted to completing chapters 34-40 of

Wheelock's Latin. For the rest of the term, primary Latin readings from Cicero's First Catilinarian Oration will be assigned on a daily basis. Students will be expected to develop their translation and literary analysis skills in prepared passages from the original Latin text.
