1. <u>Harvard Summer Program in Nafplio and Thessaloniki, Greece (Humanities)</u>

Application Deadline: January 30, 2020 Dates: TBA (usually end of June) Cost: TBA

2. American School of Classical Studies in Athens

Summer Session:

Application Deadline: January 10, 2020 Dates: June 15 to July 29, 2020

Costs: The fee for the 2020 program is \$4,900. This includes tuition, room for the entire six-week period, partial board in Athens, travel within Greece, and museum and site fees. International airfare, most meals outside Athens, and incidental expenses are the participant's responsibility.

Summer Seminars:

- a. Aegean Networks of Technology (June 8 to June 26, 2020)
- b. The Northern Aegean: Macedon and Thrace (July 2 to July 20, 2020)

Application Deadline: January 10, 2020

Costs: The fee for each summer 2020 Seminar is \$2,750. This includes tuition, room for the entire 18-day period, partial board in Athens, travel within Greece, and museum and site fees. International airfare, most meals outside Athens, and incidental expenses are the participant's responsibility.

3. <u>Lincoln College Summer School of Greek Palaeography</u>: a five-day introduction to the study of Greek manuscripts through ten reading classes, three library visits and five thematic lectures.

Application Deadline: 15 January 2020 Dates: 27 July - 1 August 2020

Costs: The school does not charge student fees. Participants are individually responsible for their transportation and living expenses in Oxford.

Latin Programs

1. <u>American Academy in Rome – Classical Summer School</u>

Application Deadline: December 15, 2019 Dates: June 15, 2020—July 24, 2020

Costs: The program fee of \$4,500 includes tuition, accommodation (double occupancy; some singles are available for additional cost), five meals per week at AAR or a local restaurant and the cost of trips to sites in and around Rome. It does not include airfare, personal expenses (or additional, unplanned expenditures), breakfasts, lunches, weekend meals, any travel not directly related to the program of the Summer School, nor expenses such as laundry, tips, amusements, or shopping.

2. Accademia Vivarium Novum: 8 Weeks of Intensive Courses - International Latin Summer School

Application Deadline: TBA

Dates: TBA (June 24th - August 18th, 2019)

Two Modules: Latin I and II

Costs: The all-inclusive cost of participation in a single module of four weeks is € 2,650. Participation in both modules (spanning eight weeks) costs € 5,200. The participation cost covers: Lessons, Membership fee, Didactic material. The Academy will provide participants with full boarding and lodging.

Excavation Programs

1. Ancient Thouria Excavation Program:

Application Deadline: May 15, 2020 **Dates**: July 12 – 25, 2020

Experience Required: None, but preference will be given to those with a background in the Classics and Ancient History/Archaeology

Costs: 1,950 Euros (includes tuition, field trips and accommodation)

2. ASCSA - Agora Excavations:

Application Deadline: December 15, 2019 Dates: eight weeks (early June - early August)

Approximately thirty-five volunteers are chosen on the basis of academic qualifications and previous archaeological field experience. Undergraduate applications are welcome, although priority is given to graduate students preparing for professional careers in classical archaeology and those willing to work the entire season.

Costs: Members of the Volunteer Staff will be provided with living accommodations in Athens at no cost during the time they are working for the excavations. Volunteers will share rented apartments in the Pangrati district of Athens, a short distance from the American School, approx. a 30-minute walk from the excavations. In addition, a modest expense allowance, the Euro equivalent of approximately \$120 per week, will be paid to each volunteer in order to cover the cost of meals.

3. Apolline Project at the Roman City of Aeclanum

Application Deadline: TBA (March 31, 2019) Dates: TBA (In 2019, the excavation season began on the 17th of June. Participants can attend for two, four or six weeks.)

The contribution to participate is 450EUR (roughly 400GBP or 510USD) for 2 weeks, 800EUR for 4 weeks, 1000EUR for 6 weeks. The contribution covers all tuition and the hostelstyle accommodation in Passo di Mirabella but does not cover travel or food.

4. Gabii Project
